**SUBJECT: REVISED EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE 2004 CALIFORNIA ELECTRICAL
CODE (CEC)**

On January 10, 2005, the Department issued Information Bulletin 2001-01 (SHL) announcing July 1, 2005, as the effective date for the 2004 California Electrical Code (CEC) based upon information received from the California Building Standards Commission (CBSC). Subsequent to the issuance of our Information Bulletin announcing the original effective date, the CBSC notified the Department that a publication delay is resulting in a one-month delay to the effective date for the 2004 CEC.

On January 20, 2005, CBSC issued Building Standards Bulletin 2005-01 announcing the revised effective date for the 2004 CEC as being August 1, 2005. The January 20, 2005, CBSC Bulletin is included on the reverse side of this Information Bulletin for your review.

All information contained in the Department's Information Bulletin 2005-01 (SHL), dated January 10, 2005, remains operative with the exception of the effective date for the 2004 CEC.
