2017 Draft CDBG NOFA Proposed Changes

NOFA Application Parameters	2016 (*)	Proposed 2017
Allowable activities per application	Three + a planning activity.	Two eligible activities + a planning activity. Housing Combo; Enterprise Fund Combo; or two Public Services, count as one activity.
Contract Limits	\$2 million	\$5 million
Housing – Housing Assistance or Housing Rehabilitation	Single Activity - \$600,000 Combo Activity - \$1 million	\$1 million - single or combo activity
Enterprise Fund – Business Assistance or Micro-enterprise	Single Activity - \$300,000; Combo - \$500,000	\$500,000 – single activity or combo
Multi-Family Rental Rehabilitation (with or without acquisition)	Up to \$1 million	Up to \$3 million
Public Facilities	Up to \$1.5 million	Up to \$5 million
Public Improvement	Up to \$1.5 million	Up to \$5 million
Public Services	Three Public Services = One activity Up to \$500,000	Two Public Services = One Activity Up to \$500,000
Planning Activity	\$100,000, up to two planning activities	\$100,000, one planning activity
Supplemental Activities	Three	One; single activity only, no combo activities.

Modify State Objective Points, to be defined in the NOFA (up to 100 pts).	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 100 State Objective points will be awarded for any proposed activity that addresses or mitigates impacts from a state- or federally-declared disaster, active at the time of application due date. 2. 100 State Objective points will be awarded for any proposed activity that meets the Urgent Need National Objective. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fair Housing Outreach (100 pts) 2. Disaster Resiliency activities (100 pts) 3. Remove Urgent Need (100 pts)
50% Expenditure Rule	Waiver not available	Waiver for shovel ready projects only. Programs are not eligible for waiver.
