**Description:** The State of California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) is the grantee of \$1,017,399,000 of CDBG-DR funds, allocated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as a result of federally-declared disasters that occurred in 2018 in Butte, Los Angeles, Ventura, Lake and Shasta counties.

The State has prepared a Draft Action Plan on how and where to use these funds in the impacted areas for submittal to HUD.

The CDBG-DR Draft Action Plan will be available for public review and comment by July 8, 2020 on HCD's CDBG-DR website (<https://www.hcd.ca.gov/community-development/disaster-recovery-programs.shtml>).

The public will be able to comment on the Draft Action Plan during the required public review period, from July 8, 2020 – August 12, 2020.

All comments are due to HCD by **5pm on August 12, 2020**.
