The Homeownership Super  
Notice of Funding Availability

(HOSN) is a one-stop shop for affordable homeownership projects and programs, streamlining two HCD programs to align eligibility criteria, scoring, and release of funds for a coordinated single application and award process that makes funds accessible to more developers and communities.



## The CalHome Program

This is a state grant program that increases homeownership for low- and very low-income households by funding counseling and technical assistance to encourage neighborhood revitalization and sustainable development, maximizing the use of existing homes and creating equitable homeownership opportunities for all Californians.

### ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS:

Local public entities, tribal entities, or nonprofit corporations

### ELIGIBLE USES:

Homeownership development project loans, first-time homebuyer mortgage assistance, owner-occupied rehabilitation assistance, technical assistance for self-help housing projects, technical assistance for shared housing programs, accessible dwelling unit (ADU) and junior ADU (JADU) programs, or acquisition of manufactured housing.

## The Joe Serna Jr. Farmworker Housing Grant (FWHG) Program

This program provides loans and grants that help lower-income agricultural workers and their families become or remain homeowners—to address and remedy the current and potential displacement of farmworker families from existing labor camps, mobilehome parks, or other housing.

### ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS:

Local public entities, tribal entities, nonprofit corporations, limited liability companies, or limited partnerships

### ELIGIBLE USES:

Homeownership development project loans, first-time homebuyer mortgage assistance, owner-occupied rehabilitation assistance, technical assistance for self-help housing projects, technical assistance for shared housing programs, ADU/JADU programs, or acquisition of manufactured housing.
