

## INFORMATION BULLETIN 2024-04 (MH, MP, SOP)

## SUBJECT: Manufactured Housing Permit Requirements—Alterations or Conversions

This Information Bulletin (IB) supersedes IB 2022-11 and clarifies the California Department of Housing and Community Development's (HCD's) permitting and inspection authority<sup>1</sup> for the alteration or conversion of the following units<sup>2</sup> in California:

- Manufactured homes
- Mobilehomes
- Multifamily manufactured homes
- Special purpose commercial modulars
- Commercial modulars

Pursuant to the Manufactured Housing Act of 1980<sup>3</sup> and California Code of Regulations, title 25<sup>4</sup>, **HCD** has sole authority for permit issuance and inspections of alterations, conversions, or the change of use of units, or to conduct inspections to obtain insignia of approval.<sup>5</sup>

Examples of conversions include changing the use, building type, or occupancy classification of a manufactured home/mobilehome (MH), converting a commercial modular to a mobilehome, or converting a commercial modular from a "B" occupancy classification to an "A" occupancy classification.

Unit owners, or their agents intending to alter or convert a unit, must submit an Application for Alteration or Conversion (HCD MH 415) and obtain a permit from HCD prior to commencing such work.

HCD's MH Alteration and Permit Guidelines, form <u>HCD MH 604</u> provides clarification on the scope of work that requires an <u>HCD MH 415</u>, plan review, and/or load calculation.

When multiple alterations are proposed to the same MH, such as plumbing, electrical, and structural, the alteration scope of work may be combined on one HCD MH 415.
