Pursuant to HSC Section 50218.6 (a)(3)(A) and (B), tribes may apply for program funds and shall be allocated funds up to their requested amount, or up to a total of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) collectively among all tribal applicants. If the total request for funds exceeds this amount, Cal ICH shall determine an

allocation methodology based on each tribal applicant's proportionate share of need relative to all tribes that submit an application for funding.

This Notice of Intent to Award is subject to execution of a written contract and, as a result, this Notice does not constitute the formation of a contract between the State and the proposed awardees. Proposed awardees shall not acquire any legal or equitable rights relative to the contract services until a contract containing terms and conditions acceptable to the State is executed. The State further reserves the right to cancel and / or modify this Notice of Intent to Award at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.
