Annually, HCD is required to compile a report detailing all contracts and subcontracts funded by CDBG and CDBG-CV, including the involvement of women-owned and minority-owned enterprises. All CDBG and CDBG-CV grantees must complete a survey for each standard agreement with HCD that has been in effect throughout the program year. 
HCD CDBG Resources

- Independent cost estimates and analyses must be conducted for all construction projects and services, regardless of the amount.
- Public notifications, public hearings, and public meetings must specify how written comments and complaints can be sent to the local government unit (including the mailing and email addresses, phone number, and times). Your public notice should also include the name and telephone number of the contact person or ADA coordinator.



Resident should be encouraged to reach out to that individual so that jurisdictions can provide accommodations for individuals with disabilities and assistance for those with limited English proficiency.

- Applicants are required to use the resolution form on the 2024 NOFA Solicitation page, with no changes to content except for the information in the fillable fields. Resolution Template of the Governing Body authorized signers include:
 - Application Representative (Section 4):
 - All application related documents (e.g., NEPA, Statement of Assurances)
 - Contract Representative (Section 5):
 - All contractual documents (e.g., Standard Agreement, Amendments, Reuse Agreement)
 - Reporting Representative (Section 6):
 - All reports after award (e.g., Financial/Activity Report, Closeout Package)

HCD Office Hours Updates

- The 2024 CDBG Application opened Tuesday, October 29, 2024, at 9:00 am PDT.
 - New Application for Competitive Solicitation closes on Monday, December 30,
 2024, at 3:00 pm PST.
 - We are no longer accepting OTC applications as the funds have been exhausted.
 - Contract execution for Competitive Applications is expected in May 2025.
 - Contract execution for OTC Applications will be on a rolling basis starting May
 2025.
 - The expenditure deadline is 2 years and 9 months from contract execution.
- A jurisdiction's Housing Element must be submitted to HCD and be at least in "Draft" status at the time of application submission to be considered an eligible applicant
