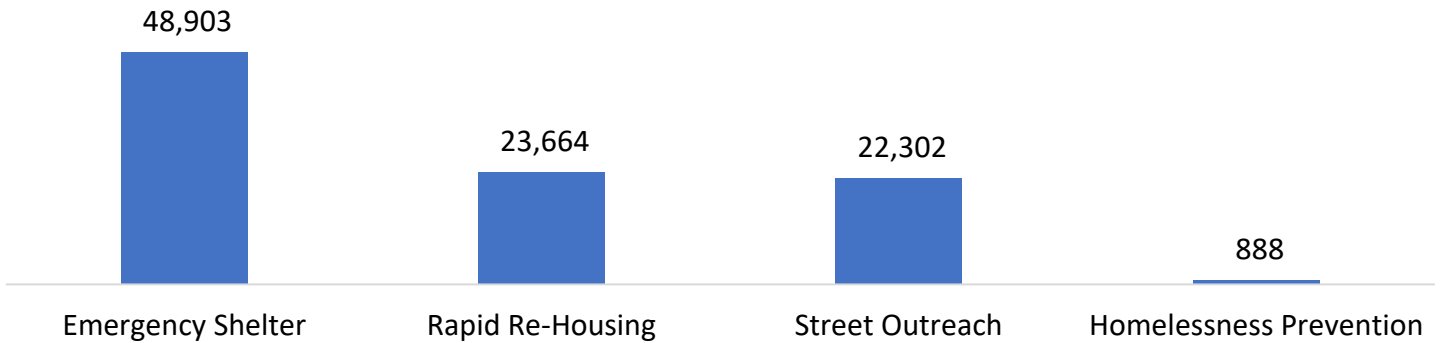
California's ESG-CV performance through 6/30/2023

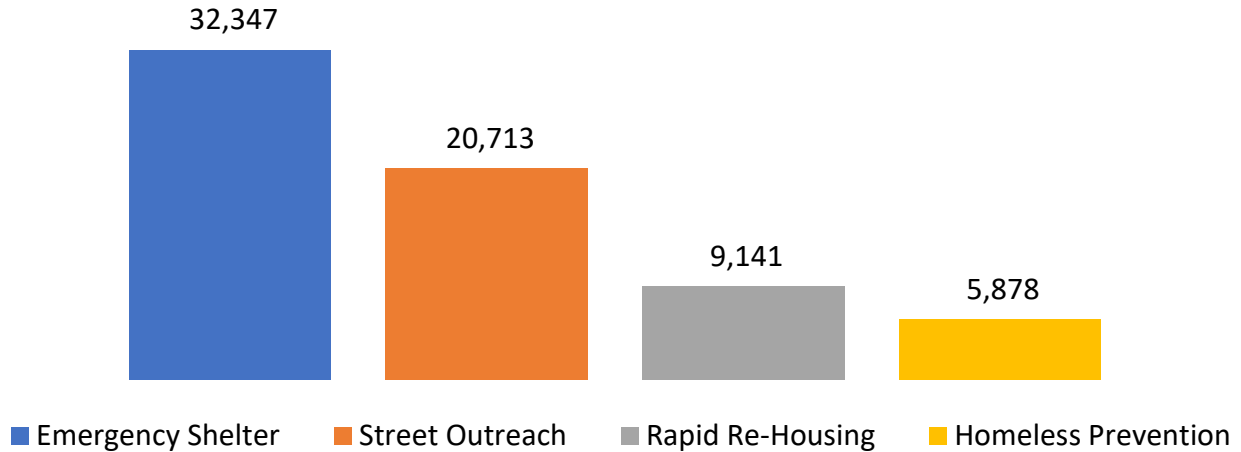

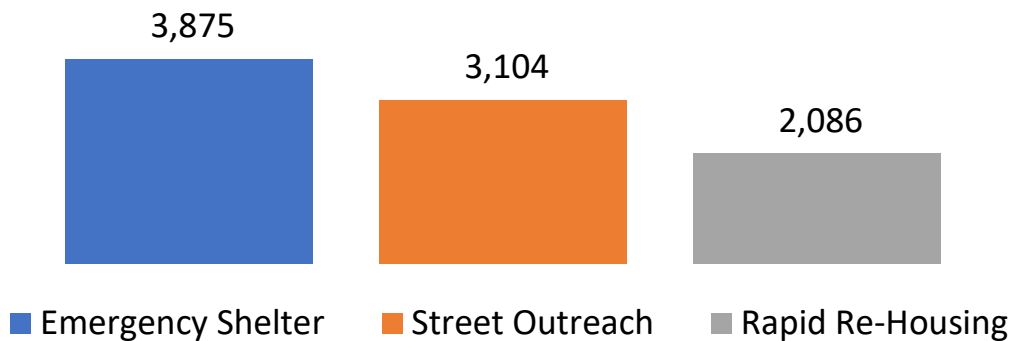

Positive Destinations by Project Type



A positive destination from an emergency shelter or rapid re-housing project is when someone is permanently housed (i.e., person moves into a rental property or reunited with family). A positive destination from a street outreach project is when someone is permanently housed or exits into a temporary situation such as emergency shelter, or temporarily moved in with family.

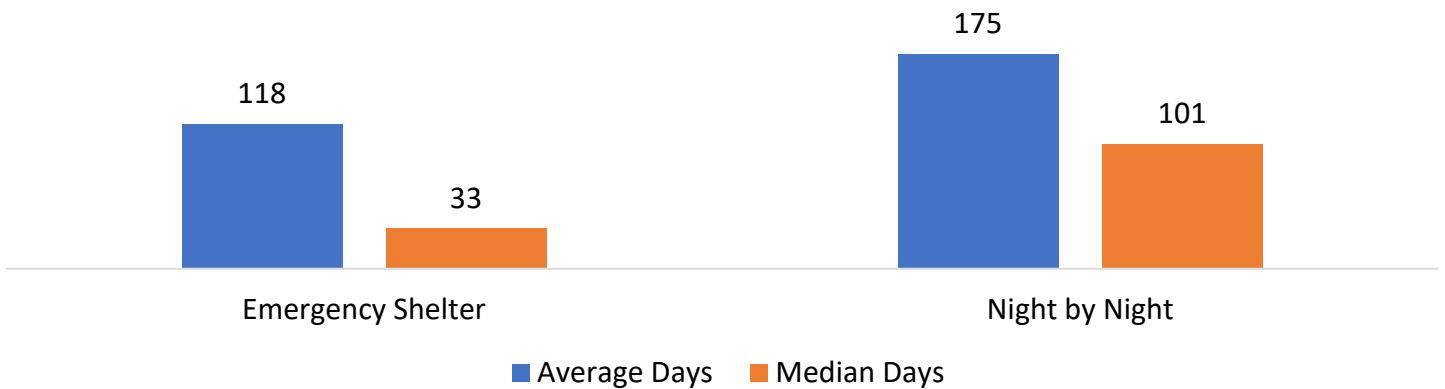

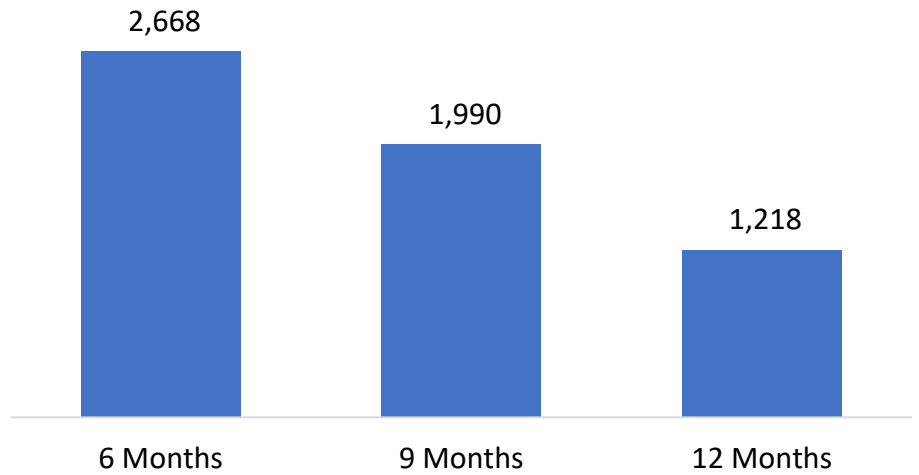
