## NOTICE: REDEVELOPMENT HOUSING SUCCESSORS

**SUBJECT**: Annual Change in Maximum Allowable Administration Expenditures for Monitoring and Preserving Units Subject to Long-term Affordability Restrictions or Covenants.

**STATUTORY AUTHORITY**: Senate Bill 341 (Chapter 796, Statutes of 2013). <u>Effective Date:</u> January 1, 2014. Amendment to Health & Safety Code Section 34176.

Section 34176.1(a)(1) specifies, in part, that housing successors may annually expend up to \$200,000 to monitor and preserve long-term affordability of units subject to affordability restrictions or covenants and administer certain activities. (HCD note: expenditure cap is subject to annual Consumer Price Index change. Adjustments shall not be made that decrease \$200,000 cap)

HCD is required to annually post on its website an adjustment to the annual \$200,000 limitation based on any change in the Consumer Price Index for <u>All Urban Consumers</u> published by the federal Department of Labor (Bureau of Labor Statistics) for the preceding calendar year.

HCD will post Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for <u>December</u> that is published by the federal Department of Labor Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) to determine the change to the expenditure cap.
